Policies 1213 – 1215 are federal policy proposals and are intended to align *Common Manual* text with federal regulations and other federal publications. Policies 1216 and 1217 are correction proposals and are intended to correct or clarify existing *Common Manual* language, or conform existing text in one part of the Manual with that already in another cite. Policy 1218 is an organizational proposal that is intended to facilitate the usage of information within the Manual.
