Policy Development Snapshot February 2017

The snapshot is designed to assist the community in tracking the status of policies in development for the 2016-2017 production year of the *Common Manual*. The charts below indicate policy proposals in progress since August 18, 2016, the last date on which the Board approved policies for inclusion in the 2016 Electronic Common Manual (ECM), published in September 2016.
